One night, the Butler and the Baker each had a dream. They were very strange dreams, and the next morning, they were both upset.

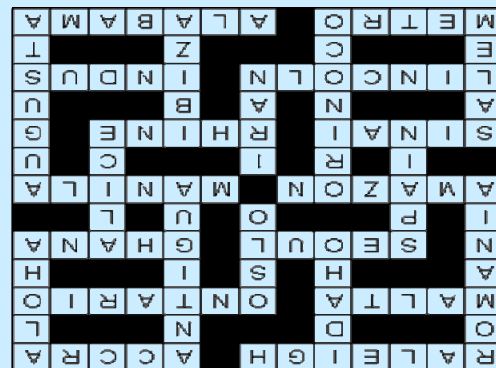
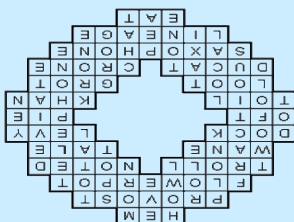
